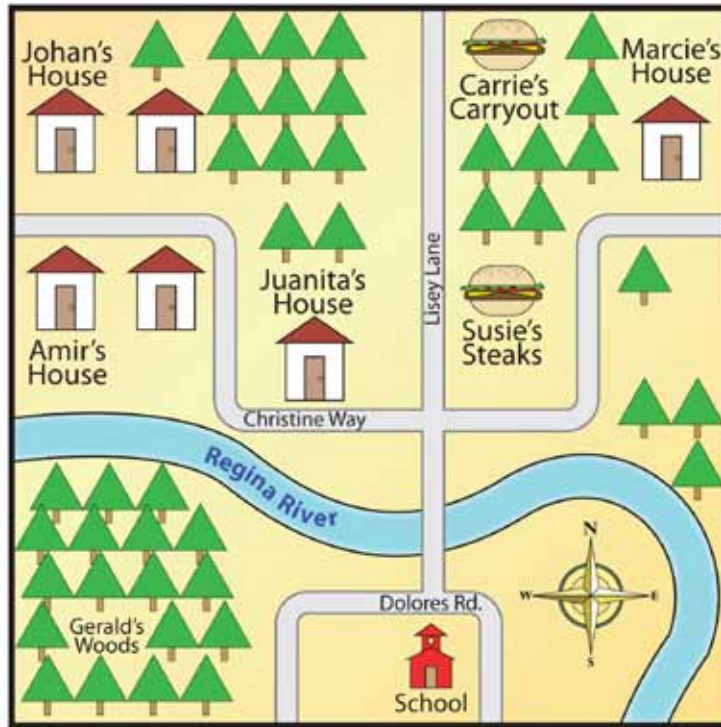
Culture
