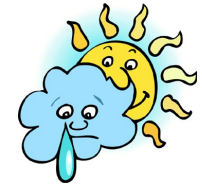

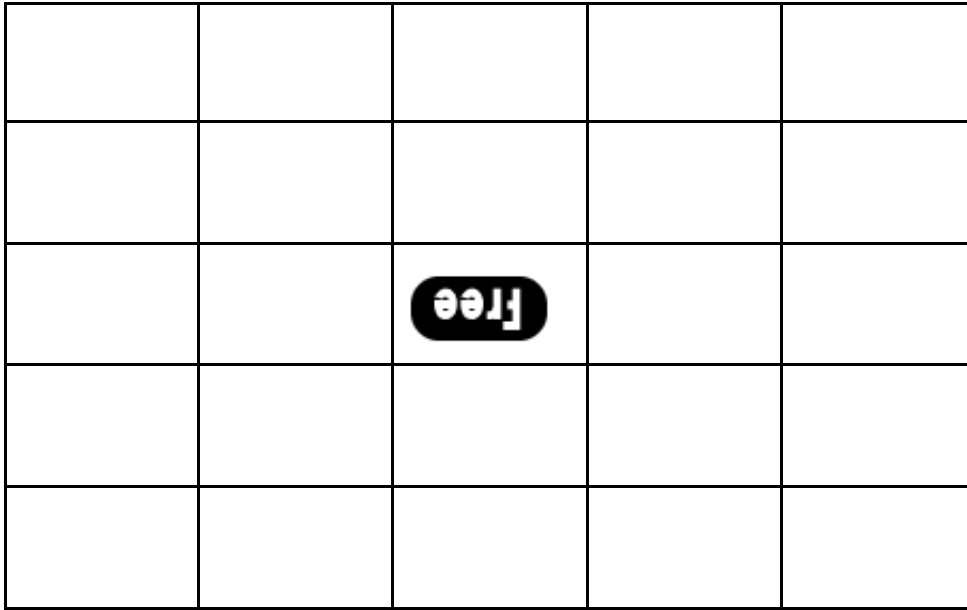

Numbers Everywhere

There are numbers everywhere when you travel.

Look how far you have gone!

Ask the driver to tell you the number on the car's odometer before you start, and when you arrive, figure out how far you have traveled.

$$\frac{\text{Ending Mileage}}{\text{Ending Mileage}} - \frac{\text{Starting Mileage}}{\text{Starting Mileage}} = \frac{\text{Total Distance}}{\text{Total Distance}}$$

How fast did you go?

To find out how fast you are traveling in a 10 minute span, ask your driver to set the trip odometer at zero. This is usually best after you stop to refuel. Set your timer for ten minutes. After that time, ask the driver to tell you how many miles you have traveled. Figure out how many miles per hour you traveled during that time.

$$\frac{\text{Miles Traveled}}{\text{Miles Traveled}} \div \frac{10}{\text{Time}} = \frac{\text{Miles Per Hour}}{\text{Miles Per Hour}}$$
