

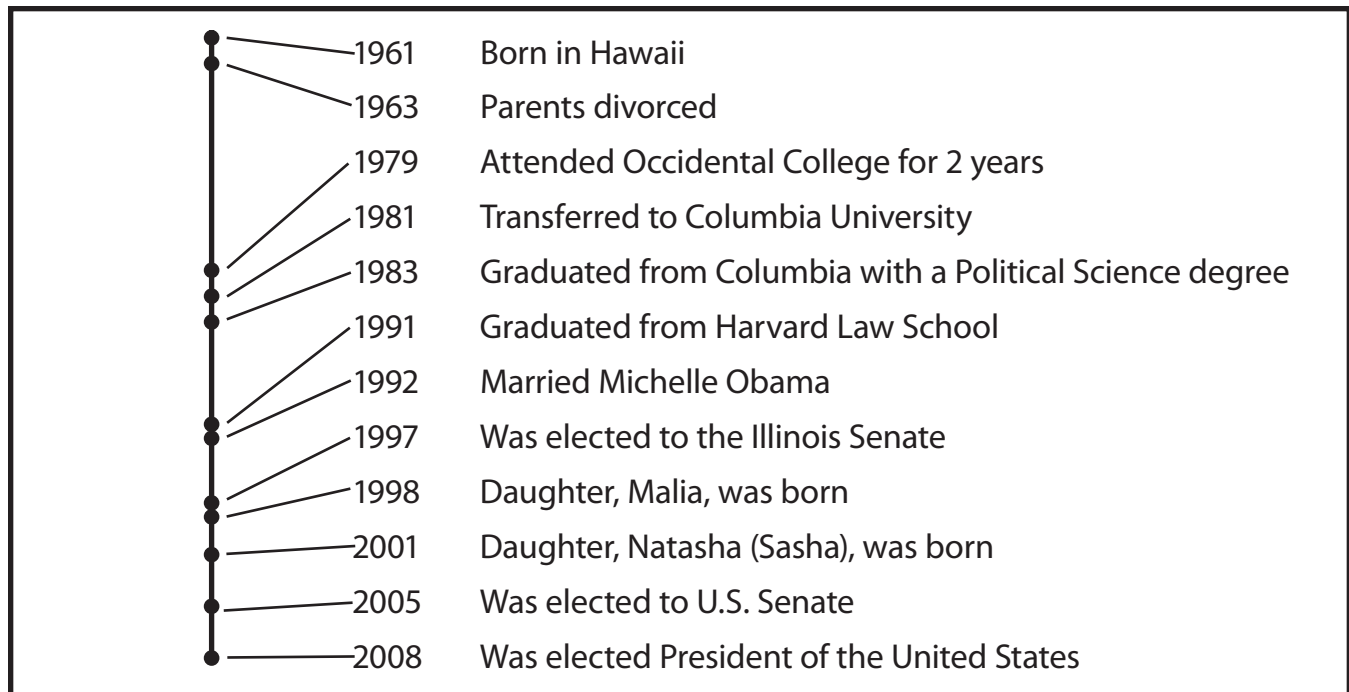
Lesson #14

Timelines

A timeline is a great way to organize events and dates. When you put information on a timeline, you can easily see how much time passed between events. There are two basic styles of timelines. On a **horizontal timeline**, you read from left to right. On a **vertical timeline**, you'll find the earliest event at one end and the newest event at the other end while reading up and down. Be sure to read the title for important information about the chart. The title usually tells you the main idea of a chart, graph, or timeline.

Look at the timeline below. The title tells us that the timeline will deal with important dates and events in the life of the 44th president, Barack Obama. We can see that Mr. Obama was 30 years old when he graduated from law school (1991 minus 1961 = 30 years). He was only two years old when his parents divorced (1961 to 1963 is two years).

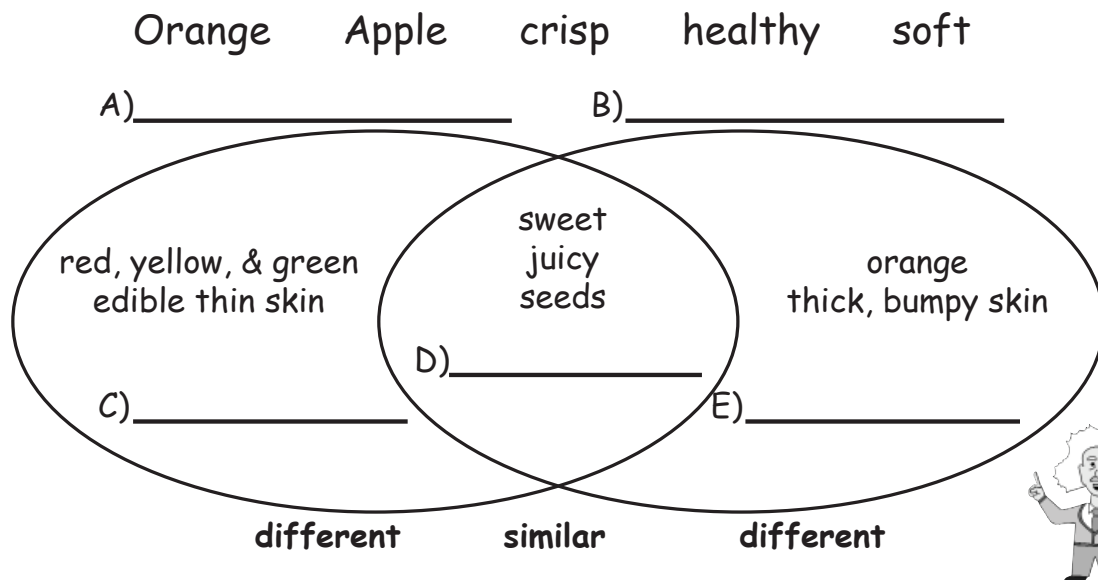
