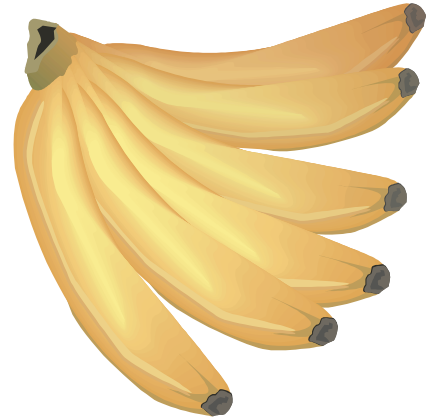


Sample Lesson #3

Goods and Services
