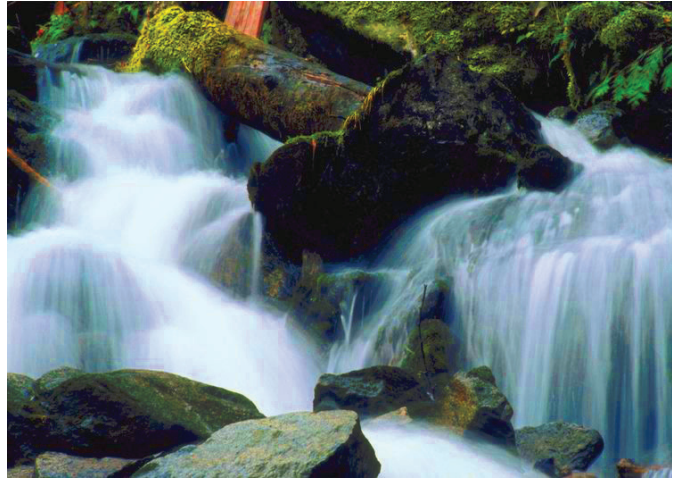


Lesson #3
