What is a Liquid?

A liquid is also a form of matter. A liquid does not have its own shape. A **liquid** takes the shape of its container. Juice, milk, and water are all examples of liquids. In the

examples to the right, the liquid takes the shape of its container. The milk in the carton has the shape of the carton. If you

poured some milk from the carton into a glass, the milk would take the shape of the glass.

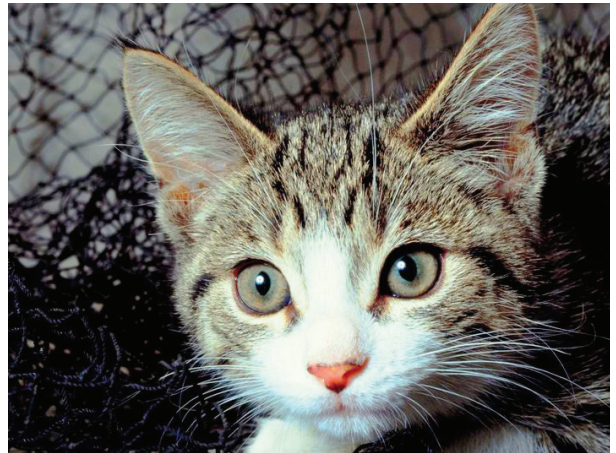
