Add an *apostrophe* (') and an *s* to each noun to show ownership.

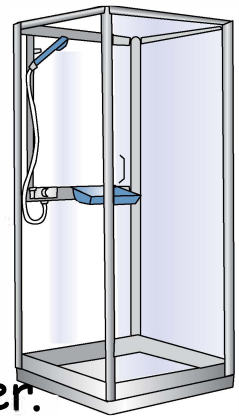

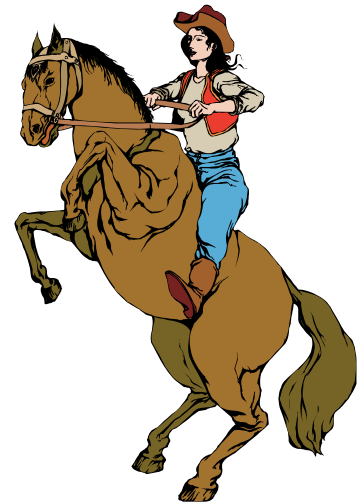
