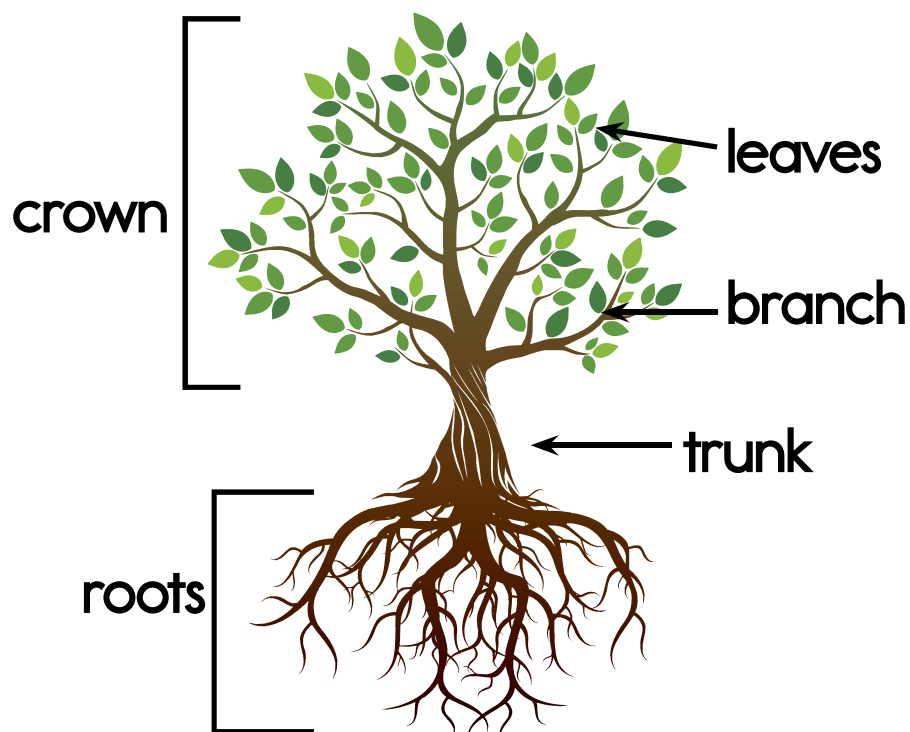


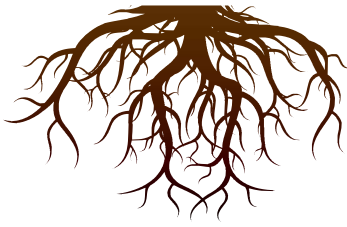
## Sample Lesson #2

# Parts of a Tree

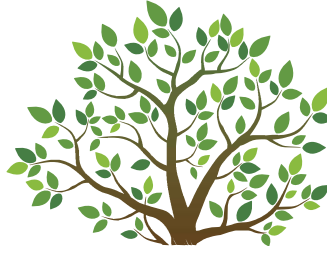
Trees have many parts. Each part has a job to do. The **roots** grow in the ground. The roots get water from the soil. They get food from the soil. The **trunk** holds the tree up. It brings water from the roots. It brings food from the roots. The **bark** is on the trunk. The bark keeps the trunk safe. The **crown** is the top of the tree. It has branches. It has leaves. The **branches** hold the leaves. The leaves make food for the tree.
