
Sample Lesson #1

Compass Rose and Map Scale

A map often has a **compass rose**. It shows the four **cardinal directions**: north, south, east, and west (N, S, E, W). The points in-between are the **intermediate directions**: northeast, northwest, southeast, and southwest (NE, NW, SE, SW).

A map may also have a **map scale**. It helps the reader figure out the distance between two places. Study the map on this page. The map scale shows that one inch represents 100 miles. One half-inch represents 50 miles. You can use this information to find the actual distance between two places.

Find the distance between Lexington and Hazard. Measure the space between the two cities with a ruler. You should find that the distance on the map is about one inch. That means the actual distance between the cities is about 100 miles. Now find the distance between Madisonville and Burlington. Measure the space on the map. Multiply each inch by 100. You should find that the distance between Madisonville and Burlington is about 200 miles.
